Baker Valley Unified School District has always strived to create a safe and positive learning environment for all students. In our effort to continue and improve our school climate, we have worked together to develop a PBIS plan. PBIS stands for Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports and is founded on the assumption or belief that all children can exhibit appropriate behavior. The primary goal is to create a positive school climate that fosters being respectful, responsible, and ready to learn.

The students learned about PBIS, at a whole school assembly on January 22, 2016, followed by a day full of relevant activities to teach this new program. A district-wide special lunch was hosted for students and staff called the Stone Soup Lunch.

In addition to our kick-off assembly, we displayed posters around the campus to reinforce positive behaviors.
