As you know, we have been granted a waiver from the California Department of Public Health and the San Bernardino Department of Public Health to open our Preschool – 5th grade. You have indicated that you would like to keep your student on distance learning. In order to meet the demands of both On Campus Learning and Distance Learning, we have shifted our distance learning students to the Edgenuity platform. Our Distance Learning students will be assigned to Ms. Jaimie Leung while they are participating in the Distance Learning program. Ms. Leung has already established contact with all of our Distance Learning families and is the main point of contact for the Distance Learning program. Below are a couple of things that I wanted to highlight as we move forward.

- Edgenuity is the main platform that your students will be working with.
- Students will meet with Ms. Leung daily to seek guidance and support, but their daily classes will be conducted through Edgenuity. Ms. Leung will set up classes and lessons that your student will need to complete.
- It will be the student's responsibility to complete the course work assigned on Edgenuity. Parents are encouraged to check their students work flow and ensure they are keeping pace with the assigned work.
- Please set up a good location for your student to work. Set a daily schedule for your students. See example below:
 - 8:00 – 8:30 Breakfast
 - 8:30 – 9:30 Work on assignments in Edgenuity
 - 9:30 – 10:00 Meet with Ms. Leung
 - 10:00 – 10:15 Snack break
 - 10:15 – 11:45 Work on assignments in Edgenuity
 - 11:45 – 12:30 Lunch
 - 12:30 – 2:00 Work on assignments in Edgenuity
